In 2016, GRICS launched Mozaïk-Portal, whose first version was exclusively for parents. The following year, basic teacher and student portals were added and developed. Finally, the addition of versions for principals and support workers has brought Mozaïk-Portal to where it is today.

Today's version of Mozaïk-Portal is designed to be a digital school hub. For this reason, we continue to make improvements so that the platform continually responds better to the various needs of all types of users.

MOZAÏK-PORTAL: THE DIGITAL SCHOOL HUB

To get the most out of Mozaïk-Portal, educational organizations need to place it at the core of their digital strategy. It is specifically designed to serve as a control centre for all key activities, including learning, communication, collaboration, monitoring and much more.

Fully centralized

With Mozaïk-Portal, everyone involved with a student has access to relevant information to ensure that learning is closely monitored. As soon as teachers post content, students and parents can access it. Mozaïk-Portal is the simplest way to share homework, assignments, subject evaluations and results.



Seamless integration with your favourite tools

If a teacher uses any of the tools listed below, their students have access to all the information and will know exactly where to find the material for each subject, since Mozaïk Portal is fully centralized.

- Online applications (e.g., Kahoot!)
- Educational websites (e.g., Class Dojo, Didacti, Alloprof)
- Documents (e.g., PDF, Word, Sheets)
- Collaborative online tools (e.g., Teams, Google Classroom)

MAIN FEATURES OF MOZAÏK-PORTAL

Communication

Posting to a message wall is the primary means of communication in Mozaïk-Portal. One of the Portal's main advantages is emails may be sent simultaneously to students and parents, whether for a particular student or the whole group. This is a great time saver! The same also applies to general messages, which can be sent to one or more groups with just a click.





Collaboration

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Mozaïk-Portal's various tools for sharing information about students promote strong collaboration. For example, automated protocols in the OIM module ensure that authorized staff are informed whenever information is added to the records of students they are monitoring.

When teachers and school staff add information to Active Monitoring and OIM, they are actually collaborating, since everyone benefits from the pooling of information. Mozaïk-Portal can even be linked with more formal collaboration tools, such as Teams and Google Classroom.

Reusable course plans

Teachers can use Mozaïk-Portal to prepare courses and evaluate students. They can modify course plans as they wish and automatically assign them to one or more groups of students.

In addition, course plans can be reused from year to year. You can schedule assignments, homework and evaluations for each teaching period of the year. All the information is automatically displayed on the timetable for all the students in the selected groups.

This tool will save teachers considerable time and energy!

OIM

Observation and Intervention Monitoring (OIM) is an integrated tool that Mozaïk-Portal uses to monitor student behaviour from day to day so that the most effective interventions can be implemented.

OIM is used to record observations and interventions concerning students. Complete with a bank of graduated descriptors that categorize the seriousness of the behaviour and standardize how observations and interventions are recorded, OIM includes a dashboard so users can see the behaviour of a group (teachers) or the entire school (principals) at a glance.

Automated protocols can be used to personalize information sharing to suit each school's needs. Everyone in charge of monitoring a student is advised when an observation or intervention is recorded about that student.

If desired, you can also share observations and interventions with parents and students.









MAIN FEATURES OF MOZAÏK-PORTAL

Active Monitoring

Offered in partnership with Optania, the virtual learning assistant will quickly become an essential day-to-day companion for teachers and other staff. Fully automated,

it supports the teacher by targeting, for example, situations that are at risk or need to be monitored, and also points out progress that deserves special attention. Students will also benefit from ViGO, their personal learning assistant, who provides individualized feedback as soon as results are entered in any subject. The virtual assistant helps students get organized and encourages every effort made in the right direction.

Bullying Management*

Bullying Management provides thorough and effective follow-up for students who have been the victim of or witness to intimidation.



Offered in partnership with Optania, Bullying Management provides support to help young people feel more secure. Whether they have been the victim of or witness to intimidation, ViGO, the virtual learning assistant, reaches out to interact with students feeling alone through the Portal, which they can even access on a tablet or smartphone. This helps prepare them to communicate with a support worker at their school.

ViGO converses with the student by asking questions and suggesting potential solutions. It always redirects the student to resources chosen by the school (such as a support worker or Tel-jeunes). This makes the entire follow-up process easier, since authorized staff have access to the information and efforts made by the student—all of which facilitates the reporting of events.

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CONCRETE EXAMPLE OF MOZAÏK-PORTAL IN USE



Let's see how Mozaïk-Portal can help Julie perform her various tasks as a teacher and enable her to collaborate with other users at the same time.

Julie is a French teacher with three secondary 4 groups. She is also the homeroom teacher for one of the groups. Julie is using a new hybrid approach to teaching: classes are taught in person on odd numbered days in the cycle and virtually on even-numbered days.

USING MOZAÏK-PORTAL IN PERSON FOR HIGH SCHOOL

Last Wednesday

Julie used Mozaïk-Portal to email the work plan for the upcoming week to all her students and their parents. The email also mentioned that links to the assignments folder had been shared in the Portal's Resources section.

Last Friday

Julie sent a reminder concerning the assignments for the upcoming week by posting a message to students and parents directly on the Portal.



When she received the notification on her phone, Flavie's mother remembered that she had to notify the school she would be picking Flavie up Monday





she used the mParent mobile application to inform the school of the reason for her daughter's absence and to let them know at what time she would be coming to get Flavie.

At the same time, Rami's parents visited their child's record in the Parent Portal to ensure that the school transportation information had been properly updated following the family's recent move.

Monday

When Julie arrives at school, she checks her daily planner on Mozaïk-Portal. She then prepares the classroom and material she will need for the day.

Julie welcomes her students and uses Mozaïk-Portal to take attendance. She notices that William is absent, which she notes and saves in the Portal. William's parents are automatically notified on their smartphones that their son is not in class. One of his parents opens the mParent application, confirms the absence and explains the reason. The school secretary receives the message and accepts the explanation provided.







CONCRETE EXAMPLE OF MOZAÏK-PORTAL IN USE (CONTINUED)

Julie is on hall-monitoring duty during recess. She notices Flavie scribbling on a locker and quickly intervenes. To correct the situation, Julie asks Flavie to clean the locker. Julie has a free period next, so she uses the time to record an observation about Flavie in the OIM module (Observation and Intervention Monitoring). She also records her intervention and links the two events.

The dashboard of Mr. Jean, the school principal, is updated with this new information. In real time, he can see the behavioural status of all students attending the school.

The school's special education technician (SET) can also see her OIM dashboard being updated. She makes a note to have a talk with Flavie and keep an eye on her behaviour.

At the end of the day, Flavie and her parents will receive an OIM message since Julie has opted to share the information with them.

Julie also uses her free period to correct student assignments and enter each student's result in the Portal's Evaluation section.

Parents receive a notification on their mobile device that a new result is available, since Julie chose to publish results on the student and parent portals.

Since she just recorded new results, Julie notices that the Active Monitoring indicators have been updated. With just a glance at her seating plan, she can quickly identify which students are currently or at risk of having difficulties in her subject.

The results Julie entered are also used to update the Active Monitoring table used by Mr. Jean. In real time, he can monitor the status of results in any subject for all students in the school.

Julie also uses Active Monitoring and OIM to follow her homeroom group. She checks the group portrait to see how students are generally doing in other subjects, and whether there are behavioural issues.

At the same time, Julie checks the OIM module and sees that Flavie has failed to hand in a homework assignment for the third time. She notices that all three observations have been recorded by the English teacher. As Flavie's homeroom teacher, she needs to act and contact the parents. Using the Portal, she emails them to inform them of the situation and suggest a meeting.



While taking attendance in Mozaïk-Portal for the day's last period, Julie notices that Flavie has to leave early for an appointment and reminds her of this.

As the students are leaving the classroom to head home, Rami goes to see Julie because he can't remember his new school bus number. Julie checks Rami's record in Mozaïk-Portal and gives him the information.



Using Mozaïk-Portal virtually for high school



Classes will be taught virtually the next day. Julie accesses Mozaïk-Portal and checks her daily planner. She has courses to teach during the first and fourth periods.

Flavie has a French class this morning. She signs on to Mozaïk-Portal and clicks the period, accessing the link to connect with the video conference. She then goes to the Resources section for the course to access the exercises. Julie welcomes her students to the video conference (on Teams) and uses Mozaïk-Portal to take attendance. Everyone is present today! During the course, she asks students to complete an exercise that she just placed in the Resources folder. This Microsoft Forms document is a multiple-choice exercise. She has also posted the link in the discussion section for the meeting.

At the end of the course, Julie is very satisfied with her group that participated extremely well. She records an observation in the OIM module so that everyone—especially the students—will receive feedback about their excellent participation.

The SET, principal and all authorized staff can see Julie's positive feedback in Events Monitoring. Parents and students can also see the message.

Everyone concerned has their OIM dashboard updated with the new observation.

After teaching the class, Julie uses her free period to record the results for her "surprise" exercise in Mozaïk-Portal. Active Monitoring analyzes the new results and updates the group portrait, which Mr. Jean can see on his dashboard.

During her free periods, Julie begins to plan activities and homework for the upcoming week. When they are ready, she will share them on the student and parent portals.

When she posts a message to parents, they are notified on mParent, which invites them to check the Homework and Assignments section on the Parent Portal.

For their part, students can sign on to the Portal and check Weekly Assignments under the My School Life or My Classes tabs.

That evening, Flavie uses Mozaïk-Portal to check which assignments she still has to complete for the current week. She has to finish analyzing a poem for the next French class. Flavie clicks on the homework link to access the poem to analyze and also opens her document saved on OneDrive. When she finishes the assignment, she clicks her teacher's name to submit her homework by email.

While she is still on Mozaïk-Portal, Flavie notices that ViGO, the virtual learning assistant (Active Monitoring for students), has some results to share with her. ViGO also provides feedback, encouragement and some advice about her learning methods.
